Intermediate Student Expectations

As you advance to an intermediate level (green and brown belts) you are becoming leaders of the class. As leaders, it is your responsibility to set the best example you know how. As you advance, your instructors will expect you to be leaders and act accordingly.

Expectation #1: LEAD by example. When a new student joins they are looking for role models. Just like a child they will emulate those closest to them in gender, age and rank. You, as an individual, must set a good example.

Expectation #2: ALL rules of the dojang must be strictly followed. (See Rules in General attached)

Expectation #3: The 14 attitude requirements to master Tang Soo Do must be understood.

Expectation #4: Testing requirements will become MORE DIFFICULT. There are physical requirements as well as mental requirements. Your instructors will need to see progress in ALL areas before you receive the opportunity to test.

Remember, you are being tested each day in class by your ability to follow the rules of the dojang and adhering to the 14 attitude requirements.

Rules

1. Attend classes at regularly scheduled times.
2. Arrive 15 minutes prior to class beginning.
3. Keep all toes/finger nails trimmed.
4. Wear loose fitting athletic clothing to class (no shorts), or Do Bohk when appropriate.
5. No food, drinks, or gum allowed in the Do Jang.
6. Use of alcohol or drugs will not be tolerated prior to or during training.
7. No loud, abusive, or profane language permitted in the Do Jang.
8. Use of proper protocol when entering and exiting the Do Jang.
9. Always raise your hand when you have a question.
10. If arriving late to class, always ask for the instructor's permission to join class.
11. Use the restroom before or after class, not during.
12. Be respectful to all students and instructors at all times.
13. Parents or family members may not interfere or coach students at any time.
14. Attire must always be neat, clean, and pressed for class and other functions.
15. No jewelry or decorative wrist or head bands permitted during class.
16. Uniforms must be folded immediately following class and shown to the instructor.
17. What you learn in class stays in class.
